



The Northwestern Memorial Hospital Palliative Care and Home Hospice Program seeks a BC/BE palliative care physician to join our growing team.

One of the nation's pioneer palliative care and academic hospice programs, the Northwestern Memorial Hospital (NMH) Palliative Care and Home Hospice Program provides inpatient consultation throughout the Northwestern Memorial Hospital System, staffs an Inpatient Palliative Care Unit, and provides hospice care for patients throughout the City of Chicago and Cook County.

An integral part of the Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine, our service is actively involved in teaching medical students, residents, fellows, nurses, and other clinicians. Our ACGME-accredited fellowship program trains 2-3 physicians per year.

As Faculty of the Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine, the physician will:

- attend on the inpatient consultation service or in the palliative care unit
- supervise palliative care fellows, oncology fellows, residents, and medical students in a variety of settings
- collaborate with our nurse practitioners, social workers, and chaplains as part of both the inpatient palliative care service and the home hospice team
- participate in the educational activities of the service

Requirements include:

- Board certification in primary specialty
- Board certified or board eligible in Palliative Medicine
- Fellowship training in Palliative Medicine, or equivalent experience
- Interest in clinical care and teaching; participation in research efforts is encouraged, but not required
